#### THE SWEANEY FAMILY

The Sweaney Family moved to Holt County in July of 1952. Dr. Frank Sweaney opened his doors to serve the people of the county as their doctor. His wife, Iris, supported him and his practice. They made this community their home and raised their growing family in Northwest Missouri.

Dr. Sweaney died in 1960 but is remembered fondly by the community he served. Iris continued to live in Holt County, saw that her children were educated in the Holt County school system, and served her community as an elected county official in the 1970s.

Their story is the story of life in Holt County during the decade following World War II. It is told in Deborah Sweaney's book *Unpacking Memories: The Story of a Suitcase, a Country Doctor, & a Community.* 

Proceeds from the book's sale will provide funding for the Iris and Frank Sweaney Fund. This fund is earmarked to support scholarships and other opportunities to Help Holt County Kids Thrive.
